Parking: FREE parking is available in surrounding area in fairground lots.

Food: The concession stand will be open during the competition. CASH ONLY. No outside food allowed.

Music: A full sound system will be provided for the competition performance that will accommodate for CDs or IPODS.

Performance Area: All Cheer divisions will compete on a 42'x42' foam mat floor.

Performance Schedule: A tentative performance schedule will be emailed before the competition. A revised version will be emailed out approximately 3 days before the event and posted in the facility.

Routines: All-Star Routines will be done to all music and cannot exceed 2 minutes and 30 seconds. High School Cheer Routines must have a combination of music and words. Music section cannot exceed 1 minute and 30 seconds. Routine cannot exceed 2 minutes and 30 seconds.

Recreation Cheer Division: Nor Cal Fed squads MUST use YCADA rules for practice, and will compete under YCADA rules.

Jr High & High School Cheer: will be following the AACCA Safety Rules, more info can be found at <http://aacca.org/content.aspx?item=Safety/HighSchoolRules.xml> . We feel since most of our participants attend Varsity competitions we should promote the use of the same guidelines. **NEW Music guidelines are in place and ALL music must be legal by USA Cheer Standards. 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Competition Music Policies & Procedures

The cheer industry has implemented new music policies and procedures for all cheer and dance events. In order to provide a positive fair and professional competition environment the coach of the team is required to sign this form, but before signing, please read and review the following:

Proof of Licensing

- Teams must be able to provide proof of licensing, in the form of a printed copy, during registration at the event they are attending. This may include:
 - Proof of purchase from a preferred provider
 - If using a single song, receipt from purchase of single song
 - If using an editor, the editor does not have to be a preferred provider; however, they must be able to provide you with proof of purchase from a preferred provider and proof of licensing for all sound effects and voiceovers included in the mix.
 - If using a non-commercial music provider, documentation that assigns all applicable rights to the team
- If a team does not have the required paperwork, they will be given the option to count the routine verbally or perform to an approved track of music or a track with counts (provided by Chico Cheer).
- If a team does not have the required paperwork, and chooses not to count the routine verbally or perform to the approved track of music or a track with counts, the team will be disqualified from the competition and not be allowed to perform.

Music Challenges

- If there are concerns regarding a team's use of music, a Challenge Form must be completed immediately following the team's performance.
- A challenge can only be made by the official coach, advisor, director or gym owner of a team competing at the event at which the challenge is being made.
- Challenge process:
 - All Music challenges must be submitted in writing the event director immediately following the teams performed
 - There will be a \$100 fee to request a music challenge, which must be in the form of a check made payable to St Jude Children's Research Hospital.
 - Challenges will be reviewed and finalized within 48 hours of the event.
 - If the challenge is correct, fees collected will be voided. If the challenge is incorrect, fees will be donated to St. Jude.

Each team is required to have a representative remain at the music station that knows the routine and music. This representative is responsible for starting the music and stopping the music in case of technical malfunction or injury. Please make sure that all devices are fully charged, volume turned up and placed in airplane mode. If using a CD make sure it's unscratched so it doesn't skip.

I have read, understand and will abide by all the guidelines pertaining to music in the 2017-18 rules.
